



Business Sponsorship Information

The NJ Sustainability News Project provides news and information to accelerate change to a more environmentally sustainable future, and to share immediate, impactful solutions across households and communities. This project is:

- a fellowship program, funding journalists and newsrooms to produce stories
- a website for sharing stories, news, and information in various formats

NJS News has generated 181 stories to date that are searchable by county and topic on SRhub.org. Four rounds of fellowships have been completed with a fifth fellowship being developed for 2023, with advisement from university journalism faculty and newsroom editors. In the 2022 fellowship, 51 total stories were published. As of August 2022, those 51 stories had 2,560 total page views, with 52 average page views per story.
